

ENGAGEMENT ON MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR PIGS 2025

Requirements	% Supplier Compliance	Target Completion Date
Comply with all European Union laws and regulations regarding animal welfare, regardless of the country of production.	100%	
The following mutilations are strictly prohibited: tail docking, surgical castration, and teeth clipping (even partial).	100%	
Prohibit stunning and slaughter methods involving manual cranial percussion (including the killing of piglets by blunt force trauma).	100%	
Prohibit weaning of piglets before a minimum of 28 days.	100%	
The use of cages during gestation and maternity phases is prohibited.	100%	
Sows must be housed in groups throughout the entire gestation period and immediately after mating or artificial insemination.	100%	
<p>Implement the following minimum space requirements per animal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>For fattening pigs</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At least 0.5 m² per pig (8-30 kg) - At least 0.65 m² per pig (30-50 kg) - At least 0.85 m² per pig (50-85 kg) - At least 1 m² per pig (up to 110 kg) - At least 1.2 m² per pig (above 110 kg) • <u>For sows</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - During gestation: at least 3 m² per sow - In maternity: each pen must be at least 6.5 m², with at least 5 m² dedicated to the sow 	100%	
<p>Maintain higher standards for the pigs' living environment at all stages of life (maternity, post-weaning, gestating sows, and fattening pigs), including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - At least 50% solid flooring with vegetative bedding covering the entire solid area. 	100%	

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<p>- For sows, appropriate nesting materials must be provided before and during farrowing, in addition to bedding.</p> <p>- Natural light: in the case of windows, they must represent at least 3% of the floor area.</p>		
<p>Prohibit stunning methods that involve a high concentration of CO2.</p>	<p>100%</p>	
<p>Ensure that at least 10% of supplies come from farms where animals have access to outdoor space (either open-air or at least an outdoor run), without counting this space in the indoor stocking density calculation.</p>	<p>100%</p>
